24 year-old artist Kate Marshall will be exhibiting selected works in her solo show "Sweet Nothings" at Bourgeois Pig, Ingramstrasse 7, 69117 Heidelberg, Germany from 17 February – 30 April 2007. There is a private view from 1600 on Saturday 17 February and a live painting exhibition as part of the *Long Night of the Museums* from 1900 on 17 March. Gallery opening times are 1500 – 1930 mon and 1200 – 1930 tues - sat.

Kate Marshall's primarily figurative work "flirts between painting and drawing". Her self-consciously decorative pieces address the "high" and "low" art and depictions of the sexualized female image in popular culture. Kate's most recent work strays from her favoured media of acrylic on board to mono printing, allowing a new approach to recurrent themes in her work. This process is the most painterly of printing techniques and each piece is unique. For the Heidelberg exhibition, certain nods have been made to kitsch German stereotypes. Dresden and Meissen figurines feature heavily as well as a German Shepherd dog and bosom in traditional Tracht. A live painting performance featuring Kate painting the gallery ceiling will take place on 17 March, the Long Night of the Museums.

Born 1982, Kate lives and works in Devon, England. She graduated with a BA in Fine Art and Art History from Goldsmiths College, London in 2004 and has exhibited in Milan, London and at the Liverpool Biennial 2006. A busy year in 2007 begins with at Bourgeois Pig Gallery in Heidelberg, followed by exhibitions in London, Mexico City and Florence.

Established by Katharine Emery and Marcus Krause in 2006 *Bourgeois Pig* is a gallery and art-co-op presenting a platform for young, contemporary art and culture in the centre of the Heidelberg's old town. Exhibitions change every 2 to three months featuring both local and international artists.
